Chance2Sustain Seminar Invitation

Imagine Durban, The Municipal Institute of Learning (MILE) and the University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN) invite you to attend the Chance2Sustain Seminar. The Chance2Sustain project is an EU funded initiative, which is led in South Africa, by UKZN's School of Built Environment and Development Studies. It explores how governments and citizens in Indian, South African, Brazilian and Peruvian cities with differing patterns of economic growth make use of participatory spatial knowledge management to direct urban governance towards more sustainable development.

The seminar will include a presentation of the results of this research from the other 8 cities across the world by the team from the University of Amsterdam in the Netherlands as well as preliminary results from the South African case studies.

The project includes action research with urban stakeholders (communities and local government) across 10 cities:

- the role of large scale projects in shaping contemporary cities
- social movements, participatory spatial knowledge production and informal settlement upgrading
- Water governance in fast growing cities (including climate change risks and water related energy risks)
- spatial knowledge production in infrastructure planning
- and budget decentralisation.
