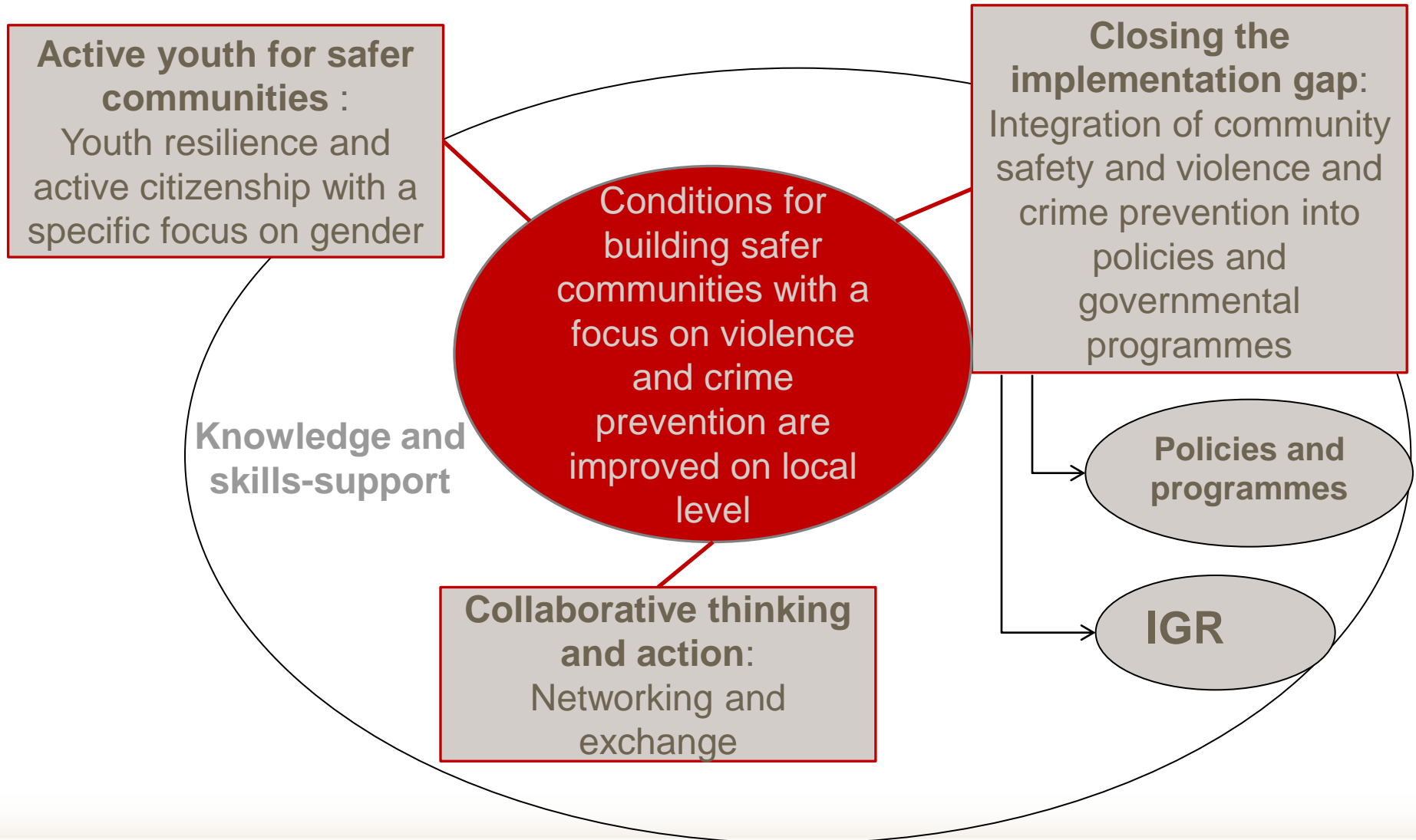


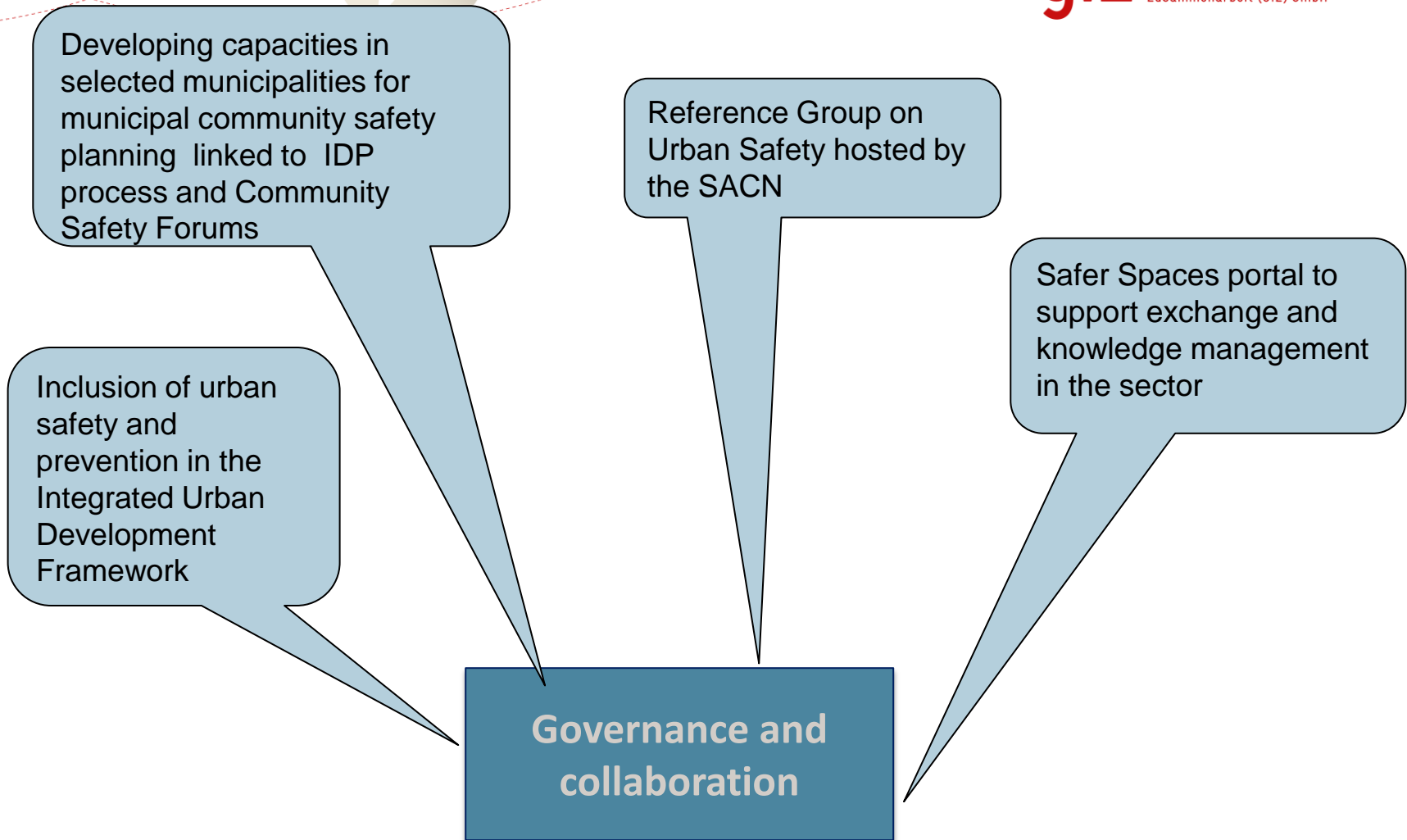
Core values

- Focus on the issue of ‘governance of safety’ and the human right to safety/safety as a public good
- Focus on the integrated approach to prevention, also live an integrated approach, e.g. with national Steering Committee
- Focus on densely populated (urban) areas and marginalised parts of the population
- Value collaborative learning and action, peer learning and networks
- Focus on local level and enhance enabling environment at sphere of LG
