Public Participation / Consultation

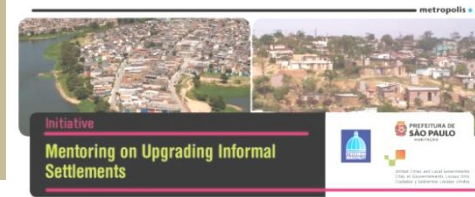
- The depth of the consultation – How much is too much
- How to interface with formal representation and organic representation
 - Councillor & ward committees
 - FBO's, CBO's, NGO's, youth organisation, etc.
 - Funding & staffing resources for participation
 - Require 3-4 full time/dedicated, qualified social development workers

Stakeholder Involvement



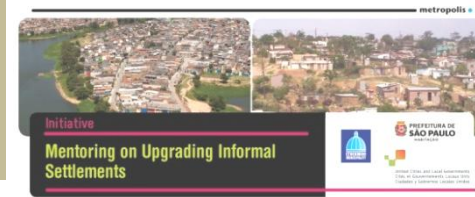
- Provincial (health, education, social development, etc) need to be involved from the start

Data Requirements



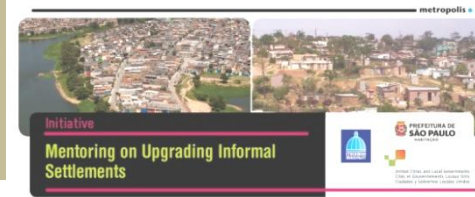
- Need for more recent data
 - Survey
 - Focus groups
- Funding for research
- Partnering with educational institutions
 - Strengthening the research component of the MOA
- Feedback to the community
- Utilising the technology for real time capturing & more innovative means of conveying the information

Local Economic Development/ Job



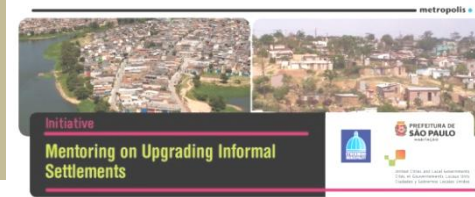
- Zibambele (road maintenance, alien plant clearing, stream cleaning, etc)
- Food security
 - Powerline servitude for gardens & grazing
- Creating sustainable local economy
- Re-cycling opportunities
- Concentrate around major roads & intersections
- Promoting LED through appropriate LUMS
- Survey of existing business for interventions
- Lack of a champion in Housing Projects
- Develop the opportunities for commercial or light industries to move into the area.

Housing



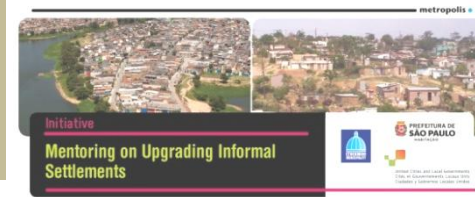
- Need for interdepartmental & provincial commitment by aligning budgets & timeframes for delivery
- Higher Housing Density is required for Public Transport & economic development opportunities is required
- Productive & creative use of open spaces
 - Eg linear parks that will link communities and create ownership of open space. Grazing spaces in areas under servitudes
- Community involvement in long term sustainable maintenance

Integrating Communities



- Link Chatsworth & Welbedacht & Umlazi & Engonyameni Area
- Linking different Parts of welbedacht
- Integrating via use of communal community facilities (sports parks, halls, etc)
- Sports & culture development programs in the area
- Survey of existing organisations in the area

Institutional Arrangements



- Assessment of need in old housing projects & commitment from respective departments to provide facilities
- Develop a plan with timeframes to deal with the past projects
- Appoint a champion/ lead department to coordinate above
- Signed Service level agreements
- Same level of commitment to lower income areas as there exist in the higher income areas/developments
